

RECYCLING IS NOW MANDATORY FOR ALL RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES, AND INSTITUTIONS IN ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP!

Beginning in 2014, the following items are required to be recycled by EVERYONE in Annville Township:

- Clear, green and brown glass, bottles and jars
- Aluminum cans
- Steel cans
- #1 through #7 plastic bottles
- Office paper
- Newspaper

So, what can you do to comply with the new rules and help preserve our environment and community?

IF YOU ARE A RESIDENT...

- ⇒ Put out your recycling bin every Monday evening and the Township-contracted hauler will be by to pick it up on Tuesday morning
- ⇒ If you need a recycling bin you can pick up one at no cost by stopping by Annville Town Hall at 36 North Lancaster Street from 8 AM to 5PM, Monday through Friday
- ⇒ Residents may also dispose of green waste, cardboard, and bulk trash at the drop-off center located at the Annville Wastewater Treatment Plant at 675 West Main Street; please call 717-867-4476 for more information!

IF YOU ARE A BUSINESS OR INSTITUTION...

- ⇒ You will need to contract with one of the following haulers to setup recycling service if you have not done so already:
