



NO-COST COMMUNITY TREE CARE TRAINING AND VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY BEING OFFERED

The Annville Township Board of Commissioners is sponsoring a no-cost opportunity open to the public for anyone interested in learning about proper tree planting, pruning, and care. This training will be a three-day event beginning with an indoor educational session on Saturday, April 29, from 9 AM to 11 AM at Annville Town Hall (36 North Lancaster Street), with a hands-on tree planting to follow in late-Spring and a hands-on pruning of trees in downtown Annville sometime during Summer. This training will be led by a certified arborist and it is intended to develop into a volunteer community group focused on caring for and preserving our community's trees, especially those in the downtown area.
