Citizens' Police Academy

The Pennsylvania State Police will be hosting a Citizens' Police Academy (CPA) in the Lebanon County area at the Lebanon County Courthouse, 400 South 8th Street, Lebanon, PA 17042. The program will expand citizens' knowledge and understanding of the law and explore police procedure from the perspective of the Pennsylvania State Police. The Citizens' Police Academy involves approximately 20 hours of instruction taught in 2 hour segments. The program is scheduled to begin [September 18, 2017 and end November 20, 2017](#). Participants meet each [Monday night for 10 weeks from 6:30pm - 8:45pm with the exception of two Tuesdays \(Tuesday, October 10th and Tuesday October 17th\)](#). Students must attend 75% or more of the scheduled classes in order to be eligible to graduate and receive a certificate.

Class size is limited to allow greater interaction between students and instructors. Citizens are selected from interested applicants. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older to apply and be a resident of Pennsylvania.
