

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
November 6, 2017**


A Public Hearing was held by the Annville Township Board of Commissioners starting at 7:15 PM on November 6, 2017 in the Commissioners' Room of Annville Town Hall, 36 North Lancaster Street, Annville, PA to hear public comment on the proposed 2018 budget.

The following members were present: Rex A. Moore, President; James W. Scott, Vice President; Thomas R. Embich, Treasurer; and Joann F. Zimmerman. Also in attendance were Nicholas T. Yingst, Township Administrator and Secretary to the Board of Commissioners; Bernard Dugan, Chief of Police; Corey Lamoureux, Esq., Township Solicitor; Luke Leininger, Union Hose Fire Company; and Anthony Deaven, Church Street.

President Moore called the Public Hearing to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

Mr. Yingst reported the hearing was properly advertised and the proposed 2018 budget had been available for review in the Township Office and on the Township website since October 20, 2017. President Moore then asked for any comments or questions from those in attendance.
