
Quittapahilla Creek in Annville needs your help. The stream bank of the Quittie is littered with trash that is unsightly and bad for the environment. Let's do something about it!

Where?

We will meet at the Annville Sewage Treatment Plant at 625 W. Main Street, Annville, PA 17003.



When?

Let's meet at 10:00 A.M. and plan to spend about two hours removing litter/trash from the streamside.

What to Wear

Participants should wear boots appropriate for mud and mucky soil. Durable pants are recommended due to potential contact with briars. You should also spray pantlegs to deter possible tick exposure. Please bring/wear durable gloves. Also consider wearing sunglasses, sunscreen, hat, and other clothing appropriate for temperature.

What to Bring

If you have a trash bag or two to contribute, great! Also, easily transportable trash cans that can be dumped would be helpful (we will be allowed to dump accumulated trash at the sewage treatment plant dumpster).

The more help we can get, the greater impact we can have. I hope to make this an annual tradition with a goal of cleaning up the Quittie from the sewage treatment plant all the way to the bridge along Syner Road between Laurel Grove Road and Old Forge Road.
