MEETING MINUTES -- MARCH 5, 2024, BOC MEETING

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Annville Township Board of Commissioners was held starting at 7:00 PM on March 5, 2024, in the Commissioners' Room of Annville Town Hall, 36 North Lancaster Street, Annville, PA with the following members present: Rex Moore, President; Henri Lively, Vice-President; Thomas R. Embich, Treasurer; Nevin Hoover; and Anthony C. Perrotto. Also in attendance were Candie L. APPROVAL OF AGENDA: MOTION by Mr. Perrotto, seconded by Mr. Lively to approve the agenda with the addition to Public Works for porta potties at the new courts on East Maple Street and add an Executive Session to reports of Special Committees. The motion carried unanimously.

3. Approval to place porta potties at the new courts on East Maple Street.

Motion by Mr. Lively, second by Mr. Moore to approve the placement of a porta potty at the courts on East Maple Street. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Public Safety</u>: The Police report was reviewed. Chief Stickler did not have anything to add to his report.

Motion by Mr. Perrotto, second by Mr. Hoover, to approve the Fire Police to aid in the Annville-Cleona Council of Churches Community Crosswalks on Friday, March 29, 2024. The motion carried unanimously.

Property: The Police Substation Project is moving along. Palmyra Borough is aware of the status of the Substation Project.

Parks & Recreation: Commissioner Perrotto reported the following:

Day of Caring is on April 20th, and the parks committee is considering signage for the historic kilns in the Quittie Park.

Finance: Mr. Embich reviewed the Finance Report for February 2024, highlighting the total income and expenses.

Zoning Officers Report: Zoning Officer Johnson reviewed the report.

Annville Activities: No report.

4. Approval of Ordinance 688 – Rental License Ordinance Updates.

5. Approval to update the Property Maintenance Code from the 2012 version to the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code and have the Township Manager be the Code Enforcement Officer.

6. Approval to collaborate with the Solicitor to update the Fee Schedule to include Sub-Division/Land Development Plan submittals.

MOTION by Mr. Moore, second by Mr. Lively to approve the preparation of the new ordinance for the updates. The motion carried unanimously.
