

INVITATION TO BIDDERS / PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT

ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Annville Township, Lebanon County, PA will receive sealed bids online for:

QUITTIE CREEK NATURE PARK STREAMBANK STABILIZATION FOR ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP

until **Wednesday, October 9, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.**, which at that time they shall be opened electronically and publicly posted on PennBid's website. All documents and solicitation details are available online at no cost on PennBid – www.PennBid.net.

The Successful bidder who is awarded the contract will be required to pay PennBID a fee ranging from 1/3% for fixed fee contracts or 1/6% of contract value (+ tax) for "Term" contracts. There is a minimum award fee of \$100 and a maximum of \$5,000. Bidders must confirm the fees associated with bidding through PennBID and the successful bidder is responsible for the fees associated with the awarded bid.

A **MANDATORY** pre-bid meeting will be held on **Friday, September 27, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.** on site at 258 Bachman Road, Annville PA 17003 (cul-de-sac at end of Bachman Road off of E. Main Street). All Questions and Answers will be addressed at the mandatory pre-bid meeting.

All bids will be reviewed by the Annville Township Board of Commissioners at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 15, 2019** in the Annville Township Town Hall Building, at which time they will award the apparent low responsible bidder, or reject all bids.

Each Proposal for the Project shall be accompanied by a Certified Check, Bank Treasurer's Check, Cashier's Check, or Bid Bond in the form provided by the Contract Documents, drawn to the order of Annville Township, and in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the Total Bid of the Proposal, as a guarantee that if the Proposal is accepted, a Contract will be entered into and the performance thereby properly secured. The work shall be substantially completed within twenty (20) calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed. Notice to Proceed is anticipated to be on **Friday November 1, 2019**, but may be subject to change. Proposals shall be valid for sixty (60) calendar days from the date of Bid opening.

Wages paid employees of the successful bidder shall be subject to the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act.

The Board of Commissioners of Annville Township reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Bids or portions thereof. Annville Township also reserves the right to overlook or "waive" a bid defect, irregularity, deficiency or nonconformance provided that: (1) same is patently insignificant or technical; (2) the best interests of the Township would be advanced by the waiver; (3) the waiver would not give an unfair advantage to one bidder over another. (4) the waiver would not violate any First Class Township bidding requirements in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SUMMARY OF WORK

The work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and appurtenances for streambank restoration along the Quittaphilla (Quittie) Creek along the Quittie Creek Nature Park walking trail, in accordance with Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) Plan found in **Appendix A**. The work will include: streambank restoration consisting of the placement of R-6 Stone for approximately 375± feet at an 8± foot width along the creek underlain with Class IV geotextile fabric; the installation of seven (7) stone stream barbs consisting of R-6 stone at a four (4) foot width placed six (6) ft into the stream; two (2) eight (8) inch PVC Pipe extensions for two exiting pipes; down tree / debris removal; and erosion and sediment control, if necessary.
