Township Facilities Update – COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus

Effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020 and Last Updated and Revised May 26, 2020

Town Hall

The Township Office at Town Hall will be closed to the public through at least June 6 due to the COVID-19 novel coronavirus. Payments and correspondence can be made by mail or through the drop slot at Town Hall; checks or money orders recommended. You can communicate with Township personnel via email at info@annvilletwp.com, voice mail at 717-867-4476, and fax at 717-867-0916. These provisions will continue to be evaluated by Township officials based upon community circumstances and State and Federal directions in order to determine future plans.

Public Works

The Public Works Department, 675 West Main Street, Annville, PA, will operate under normal business hours. Please note that the self-service dumpsters at the Public Works facility are again available for disposing of green waste and bulk trash; however, Public Works personnel will NOT provide assistance for the dumpsters and users MUST follow the social distancing requirements posted onsite. Police Department

The Police Department lobby will remain open during our regular business hours: Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM. The police office is available at 717-867-2711 and info@annvillepolice.com. We will practice social distancing and will ask people to maintain a 6-foot distance from personnel and Officers. We are also suspending all in-house fingerprinting until the end of April.

The Police Department will continue to respond to all 911 calls for service. Some non-emergency calls may be handled by phone instead of an in-person response. If an Officer meets you in person, please do not be offended if they ask you to step outside and maintain a 6-foot safety distance. Officers may also ask you to step outside when they respond to your residence.
