## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Annville Township hereby gives notice of a public hearing in accordance with the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act 247, as amended. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider an ordinance amending the current Annville Township Zoning Ordinance and zoning map, and to receive public comment on the proposed amendments. The public hearing will be held on June 4, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. prevailing time at the Annville Public Works Facility, located at 675 West Main Street, Annville, PA, 17003, unless the Governor's COVID-19 emergency declaration remains in effect on that date. If the COVID-19 emergency declaration remains in effect on June 4, 2020, the physical hearing as described above will be cancelled and the hearing will be conducted remotely on the same date and time through Zoom, an approved web-based audio and video conference platform; anyone wishing to submit public comments for such a remote hearing, or to receive instructions for participating remotely, should email [info@annvilletwp.com](mailto:info@annvilletwp.com) or call (717) 867-4476 and leave a voice mail. Additional hearings may be held as deemed necessary.
