

**DRAFT MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
November 4, 2020**

A Public Hearing was held by the Annville Township Board of Commissioners starting at 6:30 PM on November 4, 2020 in the Commissioners' Room of Annville Town Hall, 36 North Lancaster Street, Annville, PA to hear public comment on the proposed 2021 budget.

The following members were present: Rex A. Moore, President; Thomas R. Embich, Treasurer; Nevin R. Hoover; and Anthony C. Perrotto. Also in attendance was Nicholas T. Yingst, Township Administrator and Secretary to the Board of Commissioners.

The Public Hearing was called to order and Mr. Yingst reported it was properly advertised and the proposed 2021 budget had been available for review in the Township Office and on the Township website since October 15, 2020. He reported a letter had been received from the Annville Free Library regarding its Township contribution in 2021 and he shared that letter with the Board. It was further reported that no other comments had been received from the public, and it was observed that no members of the public were present to offer questions or comments. Mr. Yingst then provided an overview of the proposed 2021 budget for various funds, describing the reasons for any significant changes to revenue or expense categories from 2020 to 2021. Upon concluding, he asked if the Commissioners had any questions or comments.

Henri B. Lively, Vice President of the Board of Commissioners, arrived at the hearing at 6:35 PM.

In response to a question from Mr. Hoover, President Moore and Mr. Yingst provided information on the number of police vehicles, the frequency of their use, and the vehicle replacement plan that provides for each vehicle to be replaced every nine years.

With no further questions or comments noted, the Commissioners agreed to keep the Public Hearing in session for a few more minutes should anyone from the public arrive late. After several further minutes and no new arrivals to the Public Hearing, **MOTION** by Mr. Perrotto, second by Mr. Hoover to close the Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously and the hearing was declared closed at 6:47 PM.
