

**DRAFT MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE ANNVILLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
November 3, 2021**

A Public Hearing was held by the Annville Township Board of Commissioners starting at 6:30 PM on November 3, 2021, in the Commissioners' Room of Annville Town Hall, 36 North Lancaster Street, Annville, PA to hear public comment on the proposed 2022 budget.

The following members were present: Rex A. Moore, President; Henri B. Lively, Vice President; Thomas R. Embich, Treasurer; and Anthony C. Perrotto. Also in attendance were Nicholas T. Yingst, Township Administrator and Secretary to the Board of Commissioners; Bernard Dugan, Chief of Police; and Timothy Horstmann, Esq., McNees Wallace & Nurick LLC.

The Public Hearing was called to order and Mr. Yingst reported it was properly advertised and the proposed 2022 budget had been available for review in the Township Office and on the Township website since October 18, 2021. He reported that no correspondence pertaining to the 2022 budget had been received since the Board's last meeting on October 13, 2021. Those in attendance were invited to share any comments or questions they had regarding the proposed 2022 budget and no such comments or questions were noted. Mr. Yingst then provided an overview of the proposed 2022 budget for various funds and discussed same with the Commissioners. With no further comments or questions noted, the Commissioners agreed to keep the Public Hearing in session for a few more minutes should anyone from the public arrive late.

Those who joined the hearing late were provided an opportunity to share any comments or questions regarding the proposed 2022 budget and, as no such comments or questions were noted, **MOTION** by Mr. Lively, second by Mr. Perrotto to close the Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously and the hearing was declared closed at 6:42 PM.
