As we are sure most are aware at this point, Pennsylvania American Water Company has replaced the main water line on Maple Street in Annville. The project has impacted the roadway from the intersection of N. College Ave. to N. Weaber St. and is scheduled to be completed by the fall of 2024, as the roadway will be re-paved during 2024. During this time there will be intermittent road closures and you will not be able to park on Maple St. while work is being done.
